Guns are about firepower. A soldier without a gun in the battlefield is as good as dead. Even in war games. Players must have better weapons, if it is all about winning. An airsoft minigun can enhance your game.

Students, professionals, and the plain adventurous go for war games. They cannot be without any gun to demolish the enemy. The airsoft minigun suits them right with its impressive firepower. The velocity with which it spews the BB balls can dent tin cans, and can be very painful if you are hit in the wrong places.

Lethal Back-Up Power

The airsoft minigun is a multi-barreled firearm. It is like having a reliable back-up fire when the going gets rough. It is a sure thing you will have more hits with the minigun. The more you use this gun, the more you will love those exciting war games.

The minigun looks like the big machine guns by about 98%. The only difference is the interior system, which uses of course, BB balls. Try it on for size. It is 37 inches long and 13 inches in height. It looks so impressive for a replica.

How Does It Work?

Fire it. The M-134A2 minigun gives a 6 millimeter range for the BB balls of 0.88 grams of steel, and spews plastic BBs at a speed of 50 rounds every second. This will really scare off your opponents, or your foes will have you running tail between your legs, if you have none.

If you are waiting for the enemy behind a tree, you can fire at them when they appear 50 or 125 yards away. The velocity is powered by electricity and compressed air. This combination makes the minigun a must buy for war game heroes. Nothing beats massive and continuous firepower.

Look inside the gun. The cams and the bolts inside the receiver are housed by the central hub. Just imagine that when you fire a round of BB balls, the hub works real fast to pick up the balls and push it into the barrel. So it goes real fast. A separate loading system and bolt is contained in the barrel.

The faster the barrel of the airsoft minigun rotates and empties, the faster a new BB bullet is loaded; so you go happily firing away. For a mini, this is real mean because it shows no mercy when it spits BB balls with such speed and power.

Full Battle Gear

Browse the internet for websites carrying a line of the airsoft minigun, military get-up, and boots if you want to complete the look. To protect yourself from enemy fire, get the right gear. Use protective mask, body armor, gloves, goggles, and headgear. You will look spiffy and of course, you have protection. It is no joke to be hit with the powerful airsoft minigun.

Not the Price, But the Power

The Airsoft minigun is still evolving. Extensive research and the development are still looking into ways to make the perfect gun. At this point, there are several miniguns to choose from. Your choice will depend on your budget, and agenda.

An airsoft minigun is expensive. One gun can set you back by \$5,500. But war game freaks say, that it is all about power so the price does not matter. When your life is at stake, then who cares about the price?
